Air Travel Arrangements

We encourage you to fly in before 5:00pm Est. on Thursday, Dec. 29, 2022, or on any day you are arriving and fly out after 4:00pm Est. on Sun. Jan 1, 2023, or anytime preferable on Mon. Jan. 2, 2023.

Airport # 1: <u>CVG</u> - Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport.

Address: 3087 Terminal Drive, Hebron, KY 41048 Driving Distance: This airport is 68.35 miles / 1 hour 15-minute drive from the retreat facility.

Airport # 2: SDF - Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport

Address: 600 Terminal Dr, Louisville, KY 40209 Driving Distance: This airport is 46.85 miles / 52-minute drive from the retreat facility.

From the Airport to Agape Wilderness Retreat – Local Transportation Use the WAZE APP for accurate driving directions.

- Car Rental: You can arrange for a car rental at the airport, to enable you to drive to and from the retreat site.
- ✤ UBER / LYFT: You can arrange for UBER or LYFT pick up and drop off.
- Courtesy Ride Share: You may request to share transportation from the airport before 4:00pm on Thursday, December 29, 2022, and drop off on Sunday, January 1, 2023, between 4pm – 5pm. This is based on the availability of a guest being able to pick you from the airport on their way to or from the retreat site. This must be arranged ahead of time with the guest in question.

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Guest Information - Main Lodge









Main Lodge

- There is a cafeteria on the top floor, where food is catered for in a commercial kitchen. Water is available in the lodge for all guests.
- There is a large meeting/lounge area where members can pray or relax.

Features

- ✤ This main lodge has 6 bedrooms.
- Each room has a full or queen-sized bed and 2 twin bunk beds (can accommodate 4 other guests on the bunk beds).
- There are 2 main bathrooms (female and male): Each bathroom has 2 bath cubicles, 2 sinks (Vanity) and 2 toilets.
- There is an ironing board and an iron available for all to use.
- Some of the bedrooms have access to a porch for your outdoor relaxation.
- There is a general lounge/sitting area outside the bedrooms.

Lodging – Duplex Cabins

Cabin Features

- 1 Full size bunk bed
- 7 Twin bunk beds
- 1 Private Full bathroom: Stand in shower, toilet and sink.
- 1 Private toilet and sink
- Beddings and towels are provided

Duplex Cabins

- The cabins are ideal for families with children or just individuals who wish to share a common sleeping space.
- The cabins are next to the retreat meeting hall, where water and a beverage station are available all day. There is a microwave available as well.
- There are outdoor sitting areas that people can sit and enjoy the outdoors.

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Guest Information - Food & Drinks



This is a 4-day fasting and prayer retreat. You can fast from 6:00am to 12 noon, 6:00pm to 2:00pm, 6:00am to 4:00pm and 6:00am to 6:00pm.

- Lunch and Dinner (2 meals per day) will be served to children between the ages of 3 to 11 years each day.
- Lunch and Dinner (2 meals per day) will be served to all adults (Ages 12 & Up) each day.
- Courtesy of DCI, there will be fruit baskets and light snacks available to all guests.
- If you are traveling from out of town via air and would need to pick up some food supplies, please contact Rev. Rosemary prior to December 20, 2022. You must provide your own funds for these items to be purchased for you.

Retreat Worship Services

Attire

- Church Attire/Business Casual: You must pack appropriately, as we are in winter! Please wear appropriate clothing that cover you up properly, as worship service are always unpredictable under the move of the Holy Spirit.
- Crossover service (December 31st): Preferably all <u>white</u> outfit. However, you can substitute for other off-white colors.

Tokens/Items used in worship/prayer

- Bring your tallit or prayer shawl. You can purchase a tallit through DCI ahead of time (2 weeks prior to the retreat).
- There will be new prayer shawls, mantles and anointing oils during the retreat.

Giving

Come prepared to bless the house of the Lord.

- There is no ATM machine on the premises.
- Ensure you have adequate cash on you for offerings or if needed to purchase something off the retreat facility.
- You can bring your check book if preferred. All checks must be written to Destiny Changers International.

Arrival


- Check-in: All guests can check in after 10:00am.
